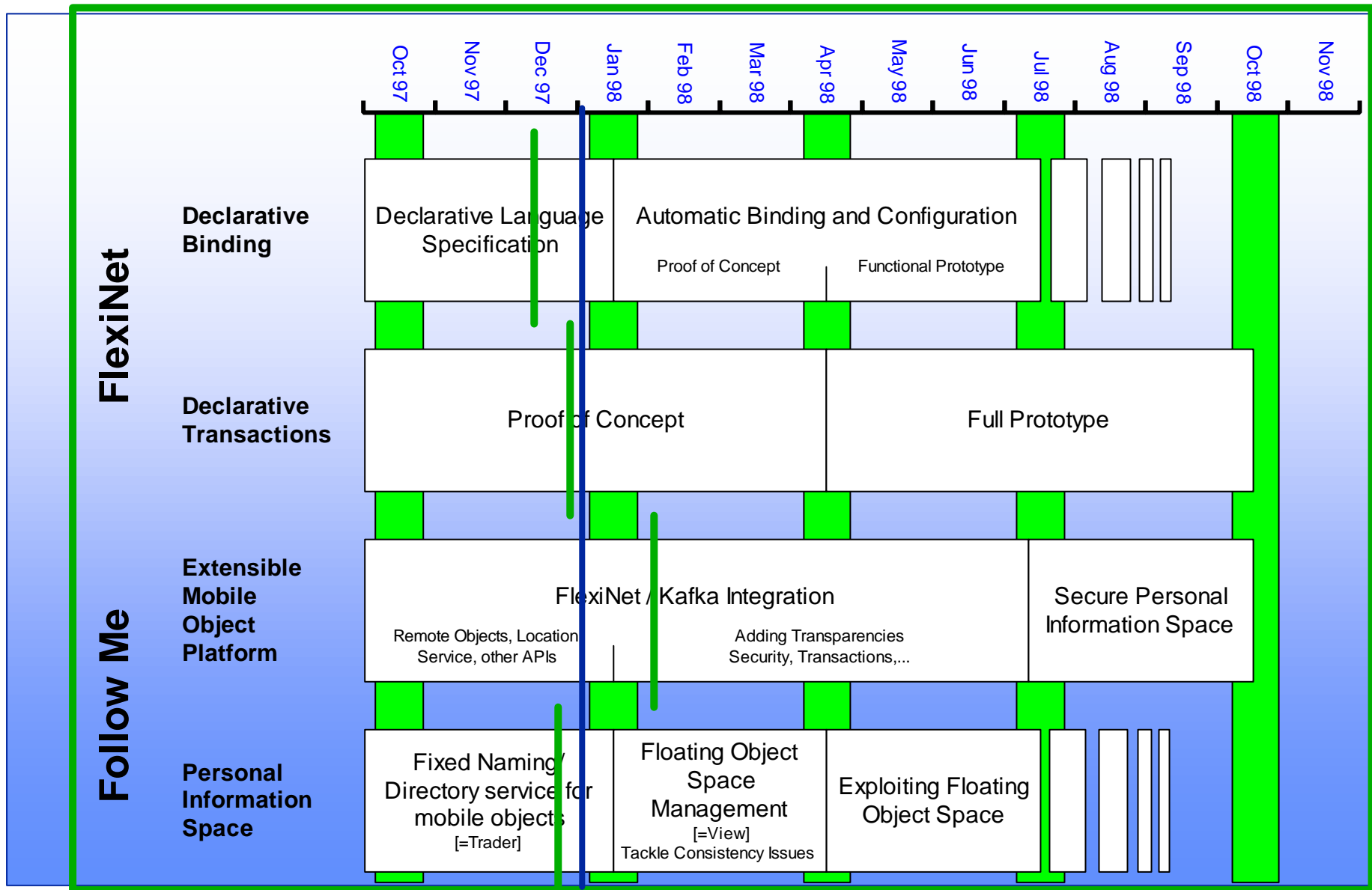

FlexiNet: Next Activities

- IIOP for CORBA inter-operability and alternative RPC binding
- SSL sessions for security
 - need secure sessions for FollowMe
 - SSL is “standard” => works with browsers, firewalls, real certification authorities etc
- Complete declarative transactions





Progress Exceptions

- Declarative Binding
 - need more components to populate framework
 - IIOP and SSL
- FlexiNet / Kafka
 - took route of adding mobility to FlexiNet taking ideas from Kafka
- Naming / location system
 - 3 stage design
 - simple scheme in place
 - evolve it as applications scale up

1998/9 Fees

- Project year starts in April

 - team of 5

 - administrative support from Yvonne
 - leverage FollowMe income



Deliverables

FollowMe Contract

- Principles of Consortium Agreement
 - each partner owns its results and first right to exploit
 - other partners have right to use
 - fair and reasonable licensing to other partners
- FlexiNet is APM background into FollowMe
- MOW & PIS are joint ANSA / FollowMe results
- Agreement to license ANSA sponsors APM rights
 - covers results produced during sponsor's membership only
 - allows use of other partner's FollowMe results
 - decouples dependence of sponsors on APM
